1. Introduction:

This booklet gives information about the Admission Procedure for Master of Law (LL.M.) Program.

3. **Duration:** This is full time **one-year** program.

4. **Eligibility criteria: (Fulfillment of all / applicable conditions mandatory)**

4.1 The candidate should have passed in the examination conducted by a recognized University leading to award of LL.B. degree (minimum 50% aggregate marks).

4.2 The candidate shall have passed the Common Law Admission Test for LL.M. (CLAT PG) / [PGCETL](#) for 2024 with valid score **or** will have to appear for Entrance test conducted by NMIMS (Deemed to-be-University).

4.3 Candidates appearing for the final year examinations are eligible to apply and examination should have been conducted before the course commencement date. If selected, provisional admission will

be given subject to clearing the final examination. Fees will be accepted from such candidates but their admission will be confirmed on the submission of final mark sheet within given due date.

- 4.4 Selected candidates must produce all mandatory documents at the time of admission. Migration certificate to be submitted in original by **30th September'2024**. Failing to meet this requirement, will result in the cancellation of admission and the fees paid will not be refunded.
- 4.5 At the time of admission, candidate has to produce semester-wise/ trimester-wise/ consolidated (only if individual mark sheets are not issued by University/Institute) mark sheet of all years of the college from which he/she is graduated. In case of internet copy of mark sheets, attestation by Principal with official seal is mandatory.
- 4.6 In case the mark sheets issued by applicable board / University is in percentile/s or grade point the actual aggregate percentage of all subjects appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- 4.7 The candidates, who have passed or, have appeared for graduation examination from a University where grade point average is given, must produce the equivalent percentage for the GPA/CGPA obtained in writing from the University concerned.
- 4.8 Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their graduation / post-graduation from Overseas University.
- 4.9 Candidates who have cleared their graduation by doing part-time course or through distance learning, correspondence courses, externally, open school from recognized University are eligible to apply and register as per UGC guidelines.
- 4.10 It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they possess the necessary and requisite qualification for the admission at NMIMS, as verification of the document is done at the time of final admission.

5. Admission Process:

Online Registration & Payment of Registration:

- Before filling the online form, please read all the instructions carefully mentioned in the instruction sheet, important dates and also Terms & Condition given in the online application form.
- Online Registration Fee of Rs.2500/- (Please refer online registration for payment details.)
- Registration Fee is non-refundable.

6. Selection Procedure:

NMIMS Entrance Test / Common Law Admission Test for LL.M – (CLAT PG) / [PGCETL 2024](#) and Personal Interview.

NMIMS Entrance Test and Personal Interview shall take place in online mode.

Note : Those candidates who have valid scores in Common Law Admission Test (CLAT PG) / PG CETL are exempted from NMIMS entrance test. Personal Interview will be conducted for all candidates.

Personal Interview : Maximum Marks: 30

- Final merit list will be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the Entrance Test & Personal Interview.
- Admission offer is given as per merit and vacancy. WAITLISTED candidates have to check their merit list status as per date given on the website.

- Once the merit list is declared, candidate has to login to check result using his / her credentials. If selected, candidate has to **accept or reject** the offer. If, offer is accepted, **SELECTED** candidate should upload necessary required document as mentioned in admission offer letter, and after verification of the uploaded documents by admission department; the candidate will get the fee payment notice e-mail (RTGS / NEFT details) for the payment of course fees within the stipulated time frame.
- Changing of preference will be considered, only if you are selected & offer given for higher preference in the subsequent merit list as per preference, merit rank and availability of seat.
- The selection will be solely based on merit.
- The cut-off for deciding the merit shall lie solely with NMIMS.

7. Program Fees:

- The Fees for Master of Law (LL.M.) Program for the year 2023-24 was Rs.2,00,000/-p.a.
- The fees for the year 2024-25 will be declared at the time of admission.

8. Important instructions:

- **For cancellation/ withdrawal of admission:** Withdrawal / cancellation means voluntary withdrawal / cancellation by candidate for any reason. Please use the below link for admission cancellation form.

Candidate has to upload cancellation form duly filled and signed along with fees paid receipt copy & cancelled cheque (personal account).

- Please note that it is responsibility of the candidate to check whether he/she is eligible to apply for the Program as per the eligibility criteria declared on the website. NMIMS has full right to disqualify a candidate at any stage of admission process if found ineligible. In such case, the admission of the candidate even if selected and fees paid stands cancelled and the fees paid will be forfeited.
- Admission to program is considered as “Provisional Admission” till all required and mandatory documents are submitted by the candidate and the same is verified and approved. If it is found that the candidate is not eligible at any stage (even after the course commencement), admission will be cancelled and fees will be refunded as per refund rule clauses even if selected/ admitted to the program.
- Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide. All announcements from the University will be through its web site www.nmims.edu. No separate call letter / admission offer letter (if selected) will be sent by email / courier / post.

- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her in the application form is incorrect, his/her application for admission to the program, even if selected, will stand cancelled and fees will be forfeited.
- Candidate's documents will be verified at the time of admission (if selected) & if found not eligible, admission will be cancelled and fees will be refunded as per prescribed refund rule.
- Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate.
- All matters of disputes will be subject to the legal jurisdiction of Mumbai only.
- NMIMS has full right to disqualify a candidate at any stage of admission process if found ineligible. No separate intimation will be given.
