#### **1. Introduction:**

This booklet gives information about the Admission Procedure for B.A., LL.B. (Hons.)& B.B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) (5 years integrated program/s)

#### 2. Program & Intake:

#### 3. Important Dates:

Start date for online registration: Monday, 30<sup>th</sup> January 2017. Last date for online registration: Wednesday, 14<sup>th</sup> June'2017

#### 4. Duration of the course: 5 Years

#### 5. Eligibility Criteria: (Fulfillment all / applicable conditions mandatory)

- 5.1 The candidate must have passed 10 + 2 or equivalent exam including International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB Certificate / & D.P. Awarded candidates are **not eligible**) in any stream from a recognized board at the first/one attempt and obtained minimum 50% aggregate marks.
- 5.2 CLAT Score is Mandatory for B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) & B.B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) program/s. LSAT score will be accepted, if seats are vacant after considering application with CLAT score.
- 5.3 Candidates of CBSE, ICSE, should mention in the online registration / e-admission form (if

selected) 10+2 or equivalent aggregate marks of all the subjects for which the candidate has appeared for (not best of four, five, six or seven). The candidate shall have passed all the subjects for which the candidate has appeared; aggregate percentage of all subject(s) for which the candidate has taken and appeared will be taken into consideration for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program at the time of admission.

- 5.4 In case the mark sheet issued by the applicable Board / Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- 5.5 Age restriction of 20 years has been removed as per the Supreme Court Interim Order. However, the candidature and admission of such applicants shall be subject to the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter which is listed for final hearing in the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of July'2017.
- 5.6 For IB & Cambridge Candidate: Candidates called for admission on the basis of merit list and who do not have final mark sheet will be given "Provisional Admission" based on predicted scores. Fees will be accepted from such candidate but their admission will be confirmed on submission of final mark sheet before the commencement of the program if found eligible.
- 5.7 Submission of AIU certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their (10+2) examination from Overseas Universities.
- 5.8 Candidates passing (10+2) or equivalent examination from Open or Distance learning (ODL) school recognized only by National Institute of Open schooling (NIOS) can apply for the program subject to the fulfillment of eligibility criteria/s of the program & candidates who have passed the (10+2) equivalent examination by doing a part-time course or through distance learning / correspondence / externally / open school other than NIOS are not eligible to apply for the courses.
- 5.9 Candidates who have obtained 10+2 or equivalent through institutes recognized by National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) are eligible for admission but those candidates who have obtained 10+2 through Open University system directly without having any basic qualification for pursuing such studies are not eligible for admission.
- 5.10 Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board/University where Grade Point Average is given, such candidates must produce in writing from the Board/University concerned, the equivalent percentage for the GPA /CGPA obtained.
- 5.11 Candidate whose final marksheet is not available at the time of admission are required to

submit internet copy of result duly attested by Principal of the school / college, failing which candidate will not be admitted for the program.

- 5.12 Only single marksheet with all compulsory subjects taken and passed in one/first attempt is mandatory, no compartmentalized mark sheet will be considered.
- 5.13 The candidate who has **NOT** cleared the 10+2 or equivalent examination in the first attempt is **NOT** eligible to apply for the course.
- 5.14 Candidates appearing for their final 10+2 or equivalent examination can also apply but their admission to the courses will be subject to above criterion, obtaining the required minimum cut off marks and also producing all the necessary documents, in original, within the given stipulated time.
- 5.15 In any stage, if it is found that the equivalence certificate, 10<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> marks & CLAT score given by candidate in online form is different, such candidate will not be considered for admission and if admitted his/ her admission will be cancelled & fees will be forfeited.

## 6. Admission Process:

## 6.1 Online Registration & Payment of Registration:

- Visit <u>www.nmims.edu</u> for online registration.
- Online Registration Fee of Rs. 1200 /- (Please refer online registration for payment details.)
- Registration Fee is non-refundable.

## **6.2 Selection Process:**

- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of CLAT score & the program preferences for the course given by the candidate at the time of online registration.
- The preferences once given in online registration cannot be changed later.
- The merit list will be put up on the NMIMS website as per important dates.
- The decision of the Institute will be final in this regard and no inquiries or correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

- Candidates are required to update 12<sup>th</sup> marks & CLAT Score in online application form on or before last date of registration i.e. 14<sup>th</sup> June 2017. No score will be accepted after closure of registration. Candidate will not be considered for merit list if they fail to update the same or their result is not available during this period.
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure correct CLAT & 12<sup>th</sup> score is entered in online form

# 7. Program Fees (Subject to Change)

Program fees for 1st year B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) for academic year 2016 was Rs.1,00,000/-

Program fees for 1<sup>st</sup> year B.B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) for academic year Batch 2016 was Rs. 1,50,000/-

The fees for  $1^{st}$  year academic year 2017 will be declared at the time of admission / will be mentioned in the Admission call letter.

8. Refund Rules: The Schedule of refund of fees will be as follows:

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following four-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to HEI
(1)	100%	15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission
(2)	80%	Not more than 15 days after the formally-notified last date of admission
(3)	50%	More than 15 days but less than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission
(4)	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission

\*(Inclusive of course fees and non-tuition fees but exclusive of caution money and security deposit)

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 10% of the aggregate fees as processing charges from the refundable amount. Aggregate fees is inclusive of course fees and non-tuition fees but exclusive of caution money and security deposit.

Note: The above refund rules are subject to revision as per UGC notification (as applicable) Note: Candidates to refer Important Dates of the respective programme.
