1. Introduction:

This booklet gives information on Admission Procedure for B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) & B.B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) (5 years integrated program/s) on the basis of CLAT 2026 score.

3. Duration of the course: 5 Years

4. Eligibility Criteria: (Fulfillment of all / applicable conditions mandatory) : It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to check his/her eligibility before applying for the course

- Minimum 50% aggregate marks in 10 + 2 or equivalent examination.

Candidates should meet the following requirements in addition to the eligibility requirements listed above:

- Candidates **Diploma awarded** from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board will be considered equivalent to 10+2 examination providing they have confirmed 24 grades/credits compulsory and have passed 3 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) plus extended essay and Theory of Knowledge (TOK).

- Candidates **Diploma Programme (DP course) awarded** from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board will be considered equivalent to 10 +2 examination with 2 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 2 subjects at Standard Level (SL) OR 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) and 1 subject at Higher Level (HL)
- **a. IBCP equivalence for General Strand** (Arts, Commerce, Science, Law): Candidates Career related Programme (CP) course awarded from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board will be considered 2 DP subjects with at least 1 subject at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 3 points in each DP subject.

Additionally, it is necessary to complete at least 03 Career Related Studies (CSR) courses given by IB-approved partners, such as the World Academy of Career Program.

b. IBCP equivalence for Engineering or Medicine Strand: Candidates Career related Programme (CP) course awarded from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board will be considered 3 DP subjects (Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology or other similar subjects) with at least 1 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 03 points in each DP subject.

Additionally, it is necessary to complete at least 03 Career Related Studies (CSR) courses given by IB-approved partners, such as the World Academy of Career Program.

Addition qualifying requirements as specified by statutory agencies such as AICTE and PCI in accordance with program requirements.

- In the online registration or e-admission form (if selected) for the 10+2 or equivalent exam, candidates who have passed through any examining board (such as the State Board, CBSE, ICSE, etc.) should indicate the aggregate scores of all the subjects they have taken, opted for, and for which appeared for (not the best of four, five, six, or seven subjects).

The aggregate percentage of all subjects the candidate has opted and appeared will be taken into consideration for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program at the time of admission.

For A Level Examination (Cambridge Board) with minimum 3 subjects at advance level will be taken into consideration for calculation of aggregate percentage. Ungraded subjects/grades will not be taken into account.

- The candidate shall have passed all the subjects opted and must have appeared in the applicable examination/s in a single attempt.
- Candidate will not be eligible if any subject is marked as ungraded / fail in the mark sheet / grade sheet even if the relevant examining board declares the candidate passed. (except Cambridge Board).
- In case the mark sheet issued by any examining board reflects scores in percentile(s), point system, GPA/CGPA, or performance bands, candidates must provide the equivalent aggregate percentage. For IB board students, an official Indian conversion transcript is mandatory. If a Grade Point Average (GPA) or Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) is provided, candidates must submit the certified equivalent percentage. Please note that the actual aggregate percentage of all subjects listed on the official grade sheet will be considered for eligibility
- The mandatory subject must be taken and passed in accordance with program eligibility.
- **IB & Cambridge Candidate:** Candidates who do not have final mark sheet will be given “Provisional Admission” based on predicted scores. Fees will be accepted from such candidate but

their admission will be confirmed on submission of final mark sheet before the commencement of the program, if found eligible. The mark sheet/s / transcript/s issued by Board / University shall only be considered.

- International School/s candidates and those candidates who have completed their (10+2) or equivalent examination/s from overseas school/s / Institute/s / University will have to submit AIU/ certificate of equivalence (mandatory) to confirm their eligibility for the program as equivalent to (10+2) examination/s. This criterion also applies to candidates who have completed open school, distance learning, or correspondence courses.
- Only single mark sheet with all compulsory subjects passed is mandatory, no compartmentalized mark sheet will be considered. (Except Cambridge Board)
- Candidate whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission is required to upload internet copy / Digi Locker copy of result within 07 working days of the announcement of the final examination result to confirm the program eligibility. The candidate's admission will be revoked, if they fail to present the mandatory document within the specified timeline.
- Candidates who have cleared their 10 + 2 (12th Standard) by doing a part time course or through distance learning, correspondence course externally, open school from a recognized University are eligible to apply & register as per UGC guidelines.
- **If at any stage of the program it is found that a candidate does not meet the eligibility criteria or has furnished incorrect information in the application form, his/her admission to the course, even if already admitted, will stand cancelled. Fees will be refunded as per the applicable refund rule clause. If the candidate does not voluntarily withdraw, the University will proceed with cancellation of admission.**
- The admission information handout's eligibility requirements will serve as the only document for program eligibility. School's brochure or prospectus or any other promotional material will only be used as a guide and not be used to refer eligibility.
- The payment of fees does not confirm fulfilment of the admission eligibility criteria. Admission will be granted only after verification of all required documents and compliance with the prescribed eligibility norms.

5. Online Registration & Payment of Registration:

- Registration Fee is non-refundable.

6. Selection Process:

- Merit Lists will be declared on basis of **CLAT 2026** & the program/campus preferences for the course given by the candidate at the time of online registration.
- The preferences once given in online registration cannot be changed later.

- The merit list will be put up on the NMIMS website as per important dates.
- The decision of the Institute will be final in this regard and no inquiries or correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- Candidates are required to update 12th (10+2)/ CLAT Scores in online application form on or before last date of registration. No score will be accepted after closure of registration. **Candidate will not be considered for merit list if they fail to update the same.**
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that the 12th / CLAT Scores are entered correctly in online form.

7. Program fees for batch 2025: (For Information only).

Program fees for 1st year BA. LL.B. (Hons.) & BBA. LL. B (Hons.) for academic year 2025 was:

- Rs. 3,75,000/--p.a. for Mumbai Campus
- Rs. 2,75,000/- p.a. for Navi Mumbai
- Rs. 2,25,000/- p.a. for Bangalore
- Rs. 2,00,000/- p.a. for Indore
- Rs. 1,25,000/- p.a. from Hyderabad
- Rs. 2,00,000/- p.a. Chandigarh

The fees for 1st year academic year 2026 will be declared at the time of admission / will be mentioned in the Admission offer letter.

8. Refund of Fees in case of withdrawal/ Cancellation of Admission:

For cancellation/ withdrawal of admission: Withdrawal /cancellation means voluntary withdrawal/cancellation by a candidate for any reason. Please visit the NMIMS website for the online admission cancellation process: <https://upload.nmims.edu/admission/cancellation/>

Refund rules from competent authorities will be followed.

Note:

Please note the closure of admission / last date of admission as mentioned in the important dates of the respective program

The Candidate is requested to check the commencement date. The cancellation policy/date is applicable as the refund rule clause mentions

8. Important instructions:

- Separate Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the performance of the candidate as per CLAT SCORE 2026, vacancy & program/campus preferences given.
- Candidates will be offered Preferred Campus based on the availability of seat & candidates merit rank.

- Once the merit list is declared, candidate has to login to check result on NMIMS portal using his / her credentials.
- If selected, candidate has to accept or reject the offer. If, offer is accepted, then candidate has to upload all the documents mentioned in the admission offer letter and proceed make the fee payment.
- Changing of campus will be considered, if you are selected in the subsequent merit list as per your preference, merit rank and availability of seat.
- We need minimum 10 candidates to start a program
- No Campus change request will be considered once the candidate has accepted the offer.
- **For cancellation/ withdrawal of admission:** Withdrawal / cancellation means voluntary withdrawal / cancellation by candidate for any reason. Please use the below link for admission cancellation form.

Candidate has to upload cancellation form duly filled and signed along with fees paid receipt copy & cancelled cheque (personal account).

- Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide. All announcements from the institute will be through its website: www.nmims.edu and no individual communication will be sent to the candidates.
- Submission of physical copy of any result will NOT be entertained during online registration; candidate has to upload all required documents as listed in admission offer letter using the detail provided to upload the document at the time of admission selection only.
- If at any stage of the program, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her in the application form is incorrect, his/her admission to the course, even if selected/ admitted, will stand cancelled and fees will be refunded as per refund rule clause. Candidates' admission will be canceled by the university if they do not voluntarily withdraw
- Canvassing in any form for admission will disqualify the candidate.
- All matters of dispute will be subject to the legal jurisdiction of Mumbai only.
- NMIMS has full right to disqualify a candidate at any stage of admission process if found ineligible.
- It is sole responsibility of the candidates to ascertain whether they possess the necessary and requisite qualification for the admission to the courses at NMIMS.
- The candidate must have appeared for all his subject(s) / exams before the commencement of the respective program (s) of NMIMS (Deemed to be University). The examination of none of the subjects should be held after the commencement of the respective course. If selected, provisional admission will be given subject to clearing the final examination. Fees will be accepted from such candidates but their admission will be confirmed on the submission of final mark sheet on or before 30th September'2026. The candidate's admission will be revoked, if they fail to present the mandatory document as specified.
- Candidates whose final mark sheet of the qualified examination is not available at the time of their provisional admission, is required to submit their final marksheet copy as soon as the result declared. In such case, if the candidate fail to meet the required eligibility criteria then his admission

will be cancelled and the fees will be refunded as per NMIMS refund rules (even after course commencement).

- Admission to program is considered as “**Provisional Admission**” till all required and mandatory documents are submitted by the candidate and the same is verified and approved. If it is found that the candidate is not eligible at any stage (even after the course commencement), admission will be cancelled and fees will be refunded as per refund rule clauses even if selected/ admitted to the program.
- The admission information handout's eligibility requirements will serve as the only document for program eligibility. School's brochure or prospectus will only be used as a guide and not be used to refer eligibility.
- If a candidate is found ineligible even after commencement of the program, he / she would be discontinued from the program and fees will be paid in accordance with standard procedure.
