The Candidates must check his/her eligibility before applying for the course.

Refund Rules:

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees* remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the Higher Educational Institutions (HEI)
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission (on or before 16th August 2022)
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission (from 17th August 2022 to 1st September 2022)
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission (from 2nd September 2022 to 16th September 2022)
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission (from 17th September 2022 to 1st October 2022)
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission (from 2nd October 2022 onwards)

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 5% of the fees paid as processing charges from the refundable amount subject to maximum of Rs.5000/-
