Medico-Legal Aspects of Injury & Death on Crime & Punishment

- ✓ **Determination of crime or actus reus** [whether any crime has taken place on the basis of injury e.g; simple hurt or grievous hurt. Rule of de minimis non curat lex will apply]
- ✓ **Determination of mens rea** [by no. of blows, by nature of weapon used, by administering poison which is of rare occurrence etc]
- ✓ **Concurrence of Actus Reus & Mens Rea** [E.g; Relevance of ante-mortem burn injury]
- ✓ **Determination of causa causan or the nature of crime if victim dies of injury** [i.e; whether it will be a case of simple hurt, G. hurt, Attempt to C. H./Murder or C. H./Murder]
- ✓ **Determination of the nature of punishment of the offender** [rarest of the rare case formula, grave offences]
- ✓ **Determination of constructive liability or common intention**
- ✓ **Determination of RPD** [Defence wound is suggestive of RPD]
- ✓ **Determination of Alibi** [by looking at the injury, estimation of time of incident]
- ✓ **Determination of credibility of eye witness**
