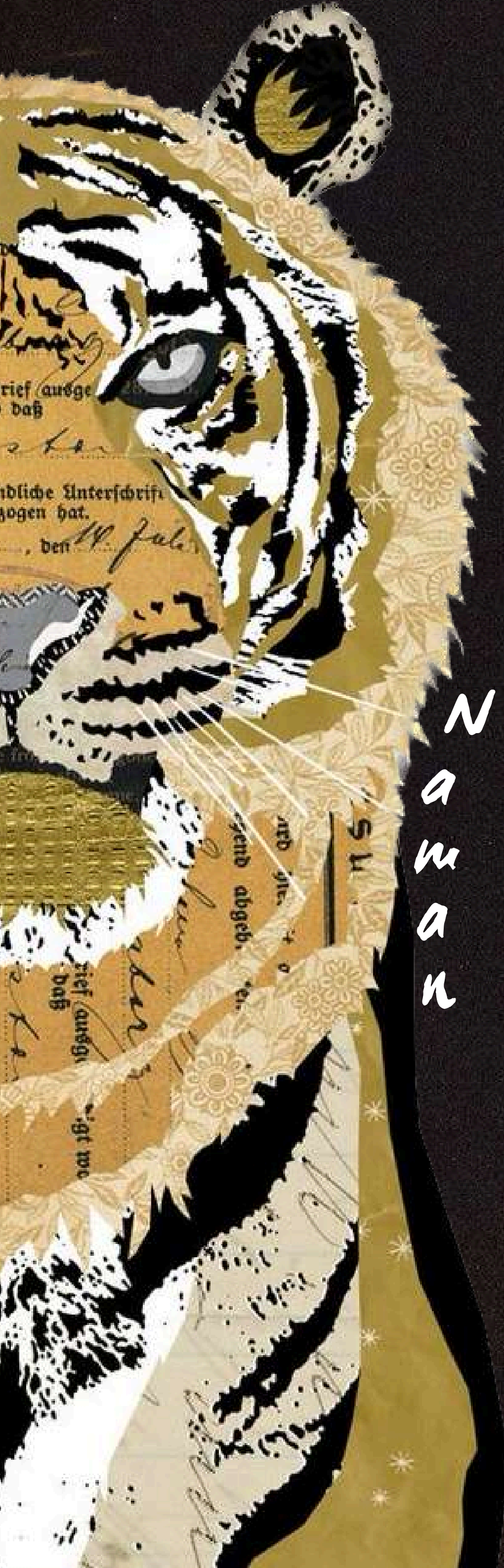
REPORTER'S NOTE
